Dear Year 5 and 6 pupils,

It is really important to me that you are not just listened to, but your thoughts and opinions play an important role in helping shaping life at the school.

There are many ways that you can be involved in helping our school's community to thrive. Some of you may have been elected school council representatives, some of you may be continuing with your work on the Sports Crew from last year and some of you may have been given roles in the classroom or doing some of the roles below to help us out.

I am writing to you to invite you to apply for the following roles:

School Ambassador – Year 6 Only

The Class Ambassadors from Year 6 take visitors around the school sharing as much information as they can about our learning community. They meet and greet visitors to the classrooms, explaining and providing a valuable context for the learning in that room. They support in the school office with administration and are our role models for supporting at activities across the school, including at fundraising events.

Sports Crew – Year 5 & 6

We have our own School Sports Crew. A School Sports Crew (SSC) is a group of pupils who work together to improve quality of school sport and PE. They also work to promote school sport and the achievements of pupils by creating newsletters, taking photographs, supporting teams and managing notice boards. Each year pupils apply for a position on the SSC, and are voted into position by their peers. The children regularly engage in leadership activities and run events for other children in the school.

Forest School Captains and Vice Captains –Year 6 only

Responsible for supporting with Forest events and collection of forest points and being the PRIDE ambassadors for your Forest. The responsibility of rewarding individual forest success is led by these people.

Lunchtime Buddies – Years 5 & 6

Our Lunchtime Buddies ensure the children are aware of our high expectations during lunchtimes as well as providing support and encouragement of our younger pupils during lunchtimes. They also award a special lunchtime buddy certificate each week in assembly.

Health and Change4Life Ambassadors – Year 5 only

Linked to the work of the school sports crew, our health ambassadors are trained pupils who are responsible for working alongside our PE Teacher and PSHE lead to promote health and well-being across the school.

If you are interested in any of the roles, please complete the attached application form and return to me by Wednesday 21st November. They will then be looked at and successful candidates will be invited to interview.
