THE SCOOTER SMART CODE

Be a Super Scooter Smart Hero!

Children can scoot to school and store their scooter in our shed.
If children want to scoot to school, all we ask is that they follow the
Scooter Smart Code:

ASK A GROWN UP

Check to make sure that it is ok to scoot to school.

BE SEEN

Wear something bright so other people and drivers can see you.

TAKE CARE BY THE ROADS

Stop, look and listen, then walk across the road with your scooter.

LOOK OUT FOR OTHERS

Make sure you can control your scooter and stop in time.

PARK YOUR SCOOTER CAREFULLY

Please don't ride your scooter around the playground - we don't
want anyone to get knocked over!
