As you may have seen in the local press, a priority for Northamptonshire Police is to reduce violent crime and young people's involvement. They launched their Community Initiative to Reduce Violence (CIRV) in January 2019. CIRV is a multi-agency and community centred project designed to reduce violent behaviour amongst gang members and those at risk of gangs across Northamptonshire. CIRV will help achieve other positive outcomes for Northamptonshire including reducing the impact and incidents of anti social behaviour, reducing the involvement of young people in crime and reducing the fear of crime.

Linked to the initiative, year 5 and 6 have an assembly on Wednesday morning, to raise their awareness of the risks to them of getting involved in anti social behaviour and how they could ask for help if needed.
